- 3. Insurance quote needed

- 5. Will work on wording for Sphere of Influence to allow Kittery to play 3-8 unless SMYFL team
- 6. Update bylaws to 24 and 36 for Gentleman's Rule
- 7. Ask Pete to attend meetings
- 8. Add option to have running clock in Defensive blitzing is only allowed in 'A' games. Scott DeFelice
- 9. MOTION to change PeeWee wording Scott, Massabesic
 During both 'A' and 'B' games, a maximum of two(2) coaches from each team are allowed on the field to aid in coaching. If a team elects to have a coach on the field as described above, that coach is considered part of the field, and should remain in the same position he/she was in at the snap of the ball for the remainder of the play. Coaches should try to select a spot that is not likely to interfere with normal play and must be at least 20 yards behind the line of scrimmage. Once the offensive huddle breaks, there will be no coaching. If there is a violation, one warning will be issued and subsequent violations will result in an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty. If one team elects to not have a coach on the field, the other team may still choose to have their coach on the field if they desire.
- 10. MOTION to Middle School Scott, Wells and Greely
 During 'B' games, a maximum of one(1) coaches from each team are allowed on the field to aid in coaching.
 If a team elects to have a coach on the field as described above, that coach is considered part of the field, and should remain in the same position he/she was in at the snap of the ball for the remainder of the play.
 Coaches should try to select a spot that is not likely to interfere with normal play and must be at least 20 yards behind the line of scrimmage. Once the offensive huddle breaks, there will be no coaching. If there is a violation, one warning will be issued and subsequent violations will result in an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty. If one team elects to not have a coach on the field, the other team may still choose to have their coach on the field if they desire.
